**Today's worship leader is Rev. Samuel A. Schreiner III.** Rev. Schreiner is the Executive Director of the Friends of Forman Christian College in Lahore, Pakistan. After this historic college was denationalized and returned to Christian control, Friends of Forman was incorporated in 2005 to raise funds in support of the mission leadership of the college, scholarship support, and capital improvements.

Previously, Rev. Schreiner was the Senior Minister of Noroton Presbyterian Church in Darien, CT. He has been a lecturer at Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary and the pastor of two churches in New Hampshire. Since 2009 Rev. Schreiner has been a trustee of Gordon College, Wenham, MA. The churches he served have always been active in missions--aiding partners in the inner city as well as overseas in Africa, Asia, and Central America. Volunteer mission trips and speaking opportunities have taken him to Taiwan, New Zealand, the Dominican Republic, Kenya, Ethiopia, Jordan, and Pakistan. Sam has a love of Scripture, especially the history and the cultural background of the New Testament, and has led multiple pilgrimages to Biblical sites in Israel, Turkey, and Greece.

Mission work runs in his family. Sam's grandfather and grandmother were United Presbyterian missionaries to India from 1915-1940. His grandfather, Dr. John C. Heinrich, taught as part of the extension program of Forman Christian College in the 1930s, and the chapel at Taxila Hospital was dedicated to him.

Sam and Deb Schreiner have been married since 1977 and have three adult children and seven grandchildren.
